

## **Remote Learning 2020-2021 School Year**

### **Elementary(PreK-6):**

Students will be provided textbooks and/or any other written material (packet) that cannot be completed through the use of computers computers.

All students and staff will be using Chromebooks and/or laptops.

Teachers, including LTAs & TAs, must log-on every day and contact students for at least 90 minutes daily...classroom contact can be made through Zoom or other platforms such as Facebook, Reflex Math, etc.....Encore Teachers(Art, Music, PE, STEM, Reading) will need to log on at least 90 minutes per week, in addition to the core teacher meetings. Special education teachers will need to support their assigned students during the assigned meeting time.

Attendance must be documented in eSchool.

Teachers will use school e-mail and/or phone to contact students and/or families, documenting any concerns/issues/barriers.

A schedule of planned topics along with assignments and meeting times should be outlined weekly and provided to the students and the main office.

### **Middle School/High School(7-12):**

Students will be provided textbooks and/or any other written material (packet) that cannot be downloaded onto computers.

All students and staff will be using Chromebooks and/or laptops.

Teachers, including LTAs & TAs, and students will follow the bell schedule. Remote learning will mirror the school schedule. Special Education teachers will need to support their assigned students during the assigned meeting time.

All teachers must have a two-day skills-based packet ready in the event that school must close immediately.

# Remote Learning--Hybrid 2020-2021 School Year

## **Elementary(PreK-6):**

Students attending will be in School—5 days per week

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday---Full Day
- Wednesday---dismissed at 12:00pm

Remote learning: for students not attending school due to a medical exemption

- Wednesday Afternoon—work will be provided for the week, classroom lessons may be provided

## **Middle/High School(7-12):**

Students will be in School for 2 days, Remote learning---Project based activities for 3 days

- Students' last names beginning with A-L will be in school Monday and Tuesday, remote learning Wednesday Thursday and Friday
- Students' last names beginning with M-Z will be in school Thursday and Friday, remote learning, Monday Tuesday and Wednesday.

Remote learning: for students not attending school due to a medical exemption

- Wednesday Afternoon—work will be provided for the week, classroom lessons may be provided
